

- 1. We require an assistant to the editor of our monthly Greensheet online publication. Time commitment would be 2 to 4 hours per month; working with the Greensheet editor and using the Constant Contact platform to prepare and distribute this event-driven publication.
- 2. Also required is a layout editor for the quarterly Timbre online publication. Using Microsoft Publisher (or a similar platform) the layout editor does the final preparation of the Timbre before it gets distributed. Time commitment would be about 6-8 hours per month..
