#### CHAPTER REMINDERS FOR NOVEMBER & DECEMBER

#### November

- As of today, only a few chapters have updated their chapter's info on the BHS MEMBER CENTER! Please get your info up-to-date.
- All Chapter information (members, director name, officers, chapter meeting locations, and more) is gathered only via the <u>BHS MEMBER CENTER</u>. The EVG Communications Team downloads the District information (about all of our chapters) from the Member Center and uses the information for distributing Greensheets, Timbres, and updating the website info about our chapters. Please make sure to update all chapter and leader information in the <u>BHS Member Center</u>.
- Assist your incoming chapter officers transition into their roles. There's good
  information and details found on the <u>CHAPTER LEADER TIPS</u> webpage. If you have
  any questions, please email <u>Sid Brown</u>, our Communications Director.

#### **December & End-of-Year Reminders**

- US Chapters: Whether you did any show this year or not, you need to make sure that the annual ASCAP forms are filed and payment were made (if applicable). (see more below)
- Canadian Chapters: FYI: The Show Clearance SOCAN License should be completed prior to your chapter shows during the year.
- General Liability Insurance. Chapters will receive a bill near the beginning of the year for general liability insurance (bodily injury and property damage). This protects the chapter, district, and society from third-party liability claims. Chapters may not opt out of this insurance policy

#### WHY CHAPTERS NEED TO GET SHOW CLEARANCES

As chapters gear up for their holiday shows, it is an important time to remind ourselves to ensure that we get the needed show clearances in advance. Show clearances provide three important features:

- 1. By licensing the music with the country-appropriate agency, chapters protect themselves and BHS from complaints or litigation over copyright infringement for use of the music.
- 2. The district secretary will check your show for any conflicting BHS or SAI shows within 60 miles on the same day. This avoids potential audience splitting between competing shows and when conflicts arise give the chapters an opportunity to join forces with the other groups for joint shows. Often chapters will get ahead of the game and work with nearby barbershop groups to build bigger and better shows and bigger audiences!
- 3. And finally, once your show is cleared, your EVG district communications team are available to help publicize your show through the email newsletter distributions and web site to let others in the district know where and when your show is taking place.

So as soon as you know where and when your show will be taking place, start the clearance process on the EVG web site at <a href="https://evgdistrict.com/show-approvals/">https://evgdistrict.com/show-approvals/</a> and reap these benefits for your chapter.
