



Have You Heard?

There will be no Division contests in the spring of 2024. Instead, the upcoming EVG District contest in Federal Way will also host the International Quartet Preliminaries for the 2024 International convention (in Cleveland). This is something new for EVG (although several other districts have been doing this for a few years). This means we'll have a larger-than-normal quartet contest, probably over 30 quartets. So, if your quartet plans to compete this fall, there are a few important things to know:


- Even with a triple panel of judges, the total number of quartets will be limited to about 35. If need be, there will be a waiting list. Don't wait until the last minute to enter your quartet via Barberscore. Entry into the contest will open July 15 and the deadline is September 22.
- On <u>Friday, October 20</u>, the contest will begin at 4pm. The first session will run from 4:00–6:00pm, followed by a one-hour break (for the judges' dinner). A second session will run from 7pm–9:30 pm. Once the (random) order of draw is completed (a few days after September 22), all quartets will be notified. All quartets should plan to sing in the first session, so plan your travel/arrival accordingly.
- The Friday night quartet evals will take place in the judges' rooms at the La Quinta. All
 quartets will receive a 40-minute eval. If you plan to opt out, please let me know
 ahead of time if at all possible. (Or you can indicate this preference on your entry
 form.)
- It is permissible to compete in more than one quartet for District awards, but please let the DRCJ know this in the 'notes' section of the entry form. That way I can ensure there is adequate space between your two quartets. On the other hand, you may not compete in more than one quartet for the International Quartet Preliminaries.
- Do make sure your quartet profile page is up to date, especially your repertoire list!

With the prelims quartets singing in the same contest with the contenders for the District quartet championship, this fall's District convention and contest is not one you'll want to miss! So if you're undecided about attending this fall's convention (particularly if you're not competing with any group), you need to make plans to attend. It's going to be fantastic!


