Clinician Debbie Cleveland, two-time International Quartet Champion (The BUZZ 2005 & Showtime 1994) stated “The Idaho Youth Barbershop Festival does a fantastic job of giving students and teachers a tasty sample of the joys of barbershop - listening and learning from the best, rehearsing, and performing at a high level, and interacting with other people who love to harmonize. I believe what makes this workshop so successful is the thoughtful care and attention of the organizers and sponsors. They focus on meeting the needs of the students and teachers, they pay attention to what works, and after feedback from all participants, they implement growth and improvement each year. On a personal level, what makes the IYBF so special is the people in and around the Boise Chordsmen, and their love and generosity of spirit. Their culture creates a safe, nurturing environment for the students and teachers to explore, question, learn and flourish in a highly rewarding barbershop day experience. 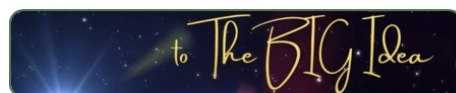
simply points them toward Boise and says, "you should start right there..."

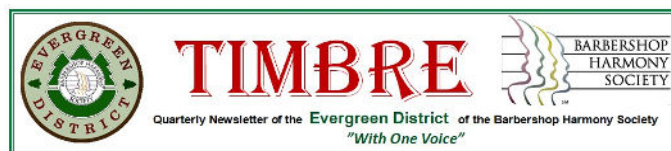
