
CONTEST VIDEOS AND PHOTOS

PDX Barbershop Quartet Takes Boise Youth Event By Storm

500+ students from nearly 30 schools participated in a three-day barbershop festival in Boise, Idaho. Two local choruses, Boise Chordsmen and Star Harmony, offered much of their valuable time to support students and sing for them on the evening show each night. Debbie Cleveland, two-time international barbershop quartet champion and music educator of the highest caliber, added memorably to the experience. PDX favorites, Argonauts, were privileged to attend as the headlining act.

Drew Osterhout has performed previously at this festival in the late '00s, back when it was a one-day event. The growth since then has been amazing, especially considering the effects of the pandemic on choirs. The Idaho Barbershop Youth Festival is a model that BHS and Districts nationwide should be studying closely.

Rich Lapp, moderator and MC for the event, taught students about the importance of music. As long as you're a barbershopper, a welcoming family of singers is available to you throughout your entire life, regardless of age or gender.
