Unfortunately, we are unable to manually process your credit card information without a US zip code, and we understand Venmo does not work in Canada.

So how do you pay?

your method of payment (CC or check). You will be issued an invoice that will be at registration with your weekend badge. To pay by credit card, bring your credit card when you arrive to pick up your badge(s)/tickets and we can process it in person.

Contest Entry Tips & Checklist

- The Contest Entry system is now open!
- The Contest entry closing date is September 6th (4 weeks prior to contest). The DRC&J will have to manually add entrants after that date.
- Your ensemble administrator begins the Contest entry process.
- The Contest entry process concludes when your administrator receives notification of contest approval from the DRC&J.

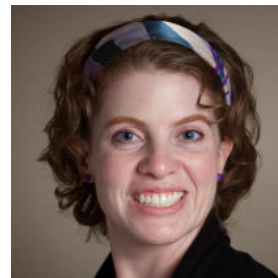

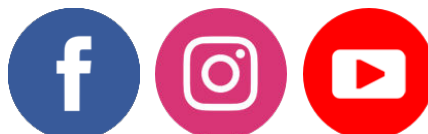
