Contest ADA Accommodations

We received word from the Newmark Theatre that their backstage elevator is out of service and will not be available for our event. We are working with the Newmark to resolve this issue by using an alternate entrance. ***It is important that you provide us with your member ADA requirements.***

- This does not affect the audience.
- The chorus matrix will begin at the Hilton with warm up rooms

on the 2nd and 3rd floors and then it is approximately a 1 block walk to the stage door entrance at the Newmark.

- The quartet matrix will begin at the stage door and there are warm up rooms backstage.

Chorus Directors, Contest Contacts, & Quartet Contacts

Please send an email to deenie0830@gmail.com once you have entered the contest with how many members of your quartet or chorus need ADA accommodations for either getting from the Hilton to the Newmark (approximately 1 block) or from the stage door to the stage (the stage is 1 floor above the stage door entrance).

Important Information for Canadian Registrants



We have figured out how to process your credit cards!

However, you still have choices.

1. If you would like to have your credit card charged immediately, **e-mail** or mail your form with the credit card information noted to Deena Wolfe, or she can take the card information via phone.
2. If you would like to pay at registration (via credit card or US check), note that on your form and you will be issued an invoice which you can pay at registration.
3. If you have already been issued an invoice, send an e-mail to deenie0830@gmail.com if you would like to have your card now charged.

Contest Entry Tips & Checklist

- The Contest entry closing date is September 6th (4 weeks prior to contest). The DRC&J will have to manually add entrants after that date.
- Your ensemble administrator begins the Contest entry process.
- The Contest entry process concludes when your administrator receives notification of contest approval from the DRC&J.

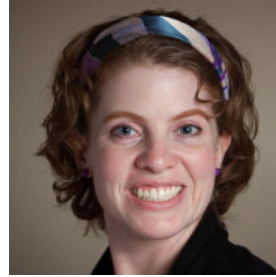
