Not only has the political situation deteriorated, but an extraordinary financial problem exists with the exchange rate. Currently \$1 US = \$1.44 Canadian, which makes it likely many Canadians will find it difficult to attend Harmony College Northwest in June.

While there is nothing we can do to ease the political difficulties, there is something we can do to ease financial difficulties. The Evergreen District Board voted that the 2025 Harmony College Northwest registration will treat the currencies as equal.




